



# Whittier Narrows Park

## Field Boundaries & Rules

### **All Fields**

Foul Territory is the part of the playing field outside the first and third base lines extended to the back of the dugout fence and its imaginary extension outward to the outfield and its imaginary extension perpendicularly upwards. Outside of this area is considered a dead ball or out-of-play area.

### **Field #1 (Field near the park exit)**

#### **Left Field Tree and Bushes**

1. A batted fly ball into tree or bushes shall be a homerun.
2. A batted ball that rolls into bushes – fielder should raise hands; ball becomes a dead ball and batter is awarded third base.

#### **Center and Right Fields**

1. All batted balls are playable.

### **Field #2 (Home plate near Rosemead Blvd.)**

#### **Left Center Field Tree and Light Pole**

1. A batted fly ball directly into tree branches is a homerun.
2. A batted fly ball that hits the light pole is a homerun.
3. A ball bouncing or rolling on ground towards tree or light pole shall remain a live, playable ball.

#### **Right Field**

1. A batted fly ball hit directly into any tree is a homerun.
2. A ball bouncing or rolling toward trees shall remain a live, playable ball.

### **Field #4 (Field on right upon entering Park)**

#### **Left Field Tree and Backstop of Field #3**

1. A batted fly ball into tree/or branches shall be a homerun.
2. A batted ball that bounces and hits tree shall remain a live, playable ball.
3. A batted fly ball hitting the backstop fence of Field #3 shall be a homerun; however, if the ball is interfered with by spectators on Field #3, the umpire shall determine base awarded at time of interference.

### Left Center Field Tree

1. A batted fly ball contacting branches and caught before touching the ground is not a catch. Ball is dead and the runner is awarded third base.

### Right Field Trees

1. A batted fly ball into the trees or branches shall be a homerun.
2. A ball touching the ground and rolling into or under the trees shall be live and playable.

### Field #5 (Field on left upon entering the park)

#### Left Field Tree

1. A batted fly ball into the tree or branches shall be a homerun.
2. A batted fly ball that clears the fence onto Rosemead Blvd. shall be a homerun.
