

WHITTIER NARROWS PARK

FIELD BOUNDARIES

ALL FIELDS

Foul Territory is that part of the playing field outside the first and third base lines extended to the back of the dugout fence and its imaginary extension outward to the outfield and its imaginary extension perpendicularly upwards. Outside of that area will be considered dead ball or out-of-play area.

FIELD # 1 (Home Plate nearest to Rosemead Blvd)

Left Center Field Tree and Light Standard Pole

1. Batted Fly ball directly into tree branches is a Home Run.
2. Batted Fly ball hitting light standard pole is a Home Run.
3. Ball bounding or rolling on ground towards tree or light standard pole shall remain a live, playable ball.

Right Field Trees (Near parking lot)

1. Batted Fly ball directly into any tree is a Home Run.
2. Ball bounding or rolling towards trees shall be a live, playable ball.

FIELD # 2 (Field near the Park Exit)

Left Field Tree and Bushes

1. Batted Fly ball into tree or bushes shall be a Home Run.
2. Batted ball rolls into bushes – Fielder should raise hands; ball becomes a dead ball and Batter is awarded Third Base (3rd)

Center and Right Fields All batted balls are playable.

FIELD # 4 (Field on Right upon entering Park)

Left Field Tall Pine Tree and Backstop Fence of Field # 3

1. Batted Fly ball into Tree and / or branches shall be a Home Run.
2. Batted ball bounces and hits Tree shall remain a live, playable ball.
3. Batted Fly ball hitting Backstop Fence of Field # 3 shall be a Home Run. However, if ball is interfered by Spectators on Field 3, the Umpire shall determine Base Award at time of Interference and Runner(s).

FIELD BOUNDARIES

FIELD # 4 (Field on Right upon entering Park) – Cont'd

Left Center Field Tree

1. Batted fly ball contacting branches and is caught before touching ground is NOT a Catch. Ball is Dead and award is Third Base.

Right Field Trees

1. Any batted fly ball into trees or branches shall be a Home Run.
2. Any ball touching ground and rolls into or under trees shall be live and playable.

FIELD # 5 (Field on the Left upon entering Park)

Left Field Tree

Batted ball into tree or branches is a Home Run.

Center and Right Fields

All are playable live balls.

All hit fly balls going over the outfield wall and into Rosemead Blvd will be considered a Home Run.
